Recycling

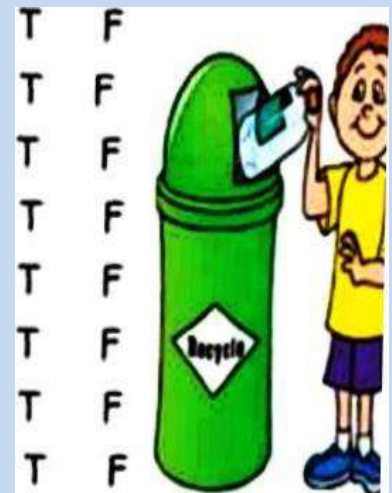
