Excellence Award for Educating Economically Underprivileged Children 2024-25

The Award carries a Trophy, a Citation and Rs. 51,000/- in cash.

Eligibility:

The Award shall be open to all teachers of government and non-government schools, from pre-school to senior secondary level all over India. Individual social activists associated who may be with an institution/NGO, may also apply.

The applicant must have at least 10 years of total teaching experience and a continuous period of 5 years, as on the date of application, of teaching full time in any of the following schools.

- (a) Schools in slum/rural areas;
- (b) School catering to the economically under-privileged;
- (c) Night Schools;

He/She should have shown sensitivity, courage and dedication to establish high standards of education despite handicaps in infrastructure. He should have encouraged less privileged children to enter the mainstream of education.

He/She should have sensitivity towards issues like health, sanitation, pollution, social evils and should have contributed effectively in these areas. The applicant must have a record of continuing social service as on the date of application.
